





Who believes in a flat earth?






Flattened Sphere


Disc Earth






Flattened Sphere







Fig. 1. Mental models of the earth.










Fig. 1. Mental models of the earth.








Conspiracy Mentality Scores






Conspiracy Mentality Scores






Science Literacy Scores



Does conspiracy mentality predict rejection of climate change?






Accept that Humans Evolved from Earlier Species of Animal








Big Organic' is smearing the GMO Industry






Russia interfered in 2016 U.S. Election
